4/1/2022 1.	2d Battalion, 4th Marines, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal Abraham Woloszyn, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongful use and possession of fentanyl. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 90 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
4/6/2022 2.	TECOM	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Sergeant Jacob T. Fiegl, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of wrongfully possessing child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 18 months confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
4/7/2022 3.	2d Battalion, 1st Marine Regiment	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal Brandon R. Kerr, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of larceny of government and non-government property. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 8 months confinement and a bad-conduct discharge.
