7/27/2022	3d Bn, 5thMar, 1stMarDiv	At a special court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal David L. Olmstead, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of domestic violence and failure to obey a lawful order. The military judge sentenced the accused to 75 days confinement, reduction to E-1, and a bad-conduct discharge.
7/29/2022	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a military judge convicted Lance Corporal Peter G. Vazquez, pursuant to the accused's pleas, of possession of child pornography and soliciting a minor to create child pornography. Consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced the accused to 60 months confinement, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, and a dishonorable discharge.
7/29/2022	1stMarDiv	At a general court-martial at Marine Corps Base Twentynine Palms, a panel of members acquitted a Marine of all charges and specifications.
